Group B Course Title: Working Together to Safeguard Children

Building on the learning from the Group A training, or its equivalent, 'Working Together to Safeguard Children', is a newly designed one day course. This inter-agency group based training seeks to enable participants to developing a clear understanding of the impact of harm on children and young people's development and of the legislation and local procedures, which are designed to protect them.

Young People and Money

Young People & Money is a FREE one-day training course that has been designed to better equip organisations, who work with young people (16- 25 yrs) who are not in education, employment or training (NEET), in providing them with a greater understanding along with supporting toolkits in order that they can help their young people make more sense of their money and hence increase their financial capability.

The core subject areas covered in the course are:

- The psychology of young people and money
- Income, budgeting and banking
- Costs of credit and comparing credit deals and options
- Debt Management including when, where and how to refer young people for money advice
- Skills to engage young people in financial matters
- Identifying practical ways to use and embed the exercises/materials in your existing work
